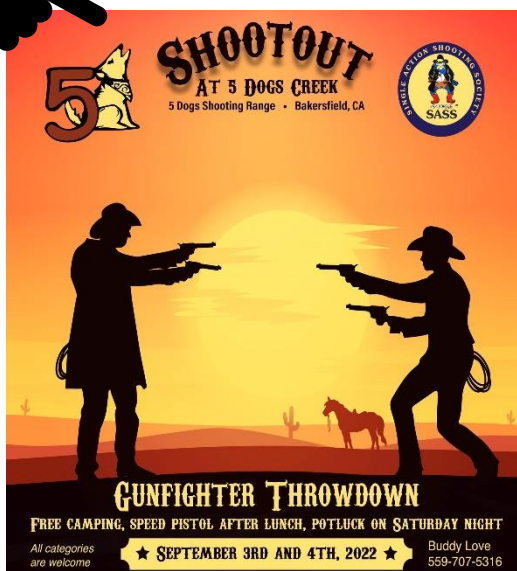

Territorial Governor's News

Mad Trapper of Rat River shared the following insightful information he gleaned from the Territorial Governor's wire just before EOT:

"HOLSTERS/BELTS:

p. 2 "Main match holsters must be located one on each side of the belly button and separated by at least the width of two fists at the belt. (Note: Pocket pistol and derringer holsters are not "main match" holsters)."

Pay attention to the words "each side of the belly button" (this is the holster at the belt and while shooting)

Might be good to use something to keep holsters in place so they do not move while shooting.

p. 3: "Ammunition belts must be worn so all ammo is positioned at or below the belly button."





SHE-BANG

The She-Bang is right around the corner on November 3-4 so get your ammo together and polish up those BB guns and .22s! We will be having hot dogs on Friday and encourage participants to bring an appetizer. Saturday will be our unforgettable potluck with a holiday theme so bring your favorite holiday dish and a copy of the recipe to share.
